The First Step that Leads the Lost to Salvation

“The Lord your God will raise up for you (out of your genealogy) a prophet like me (Moses) from among your own brothers, You must listen to Him.” Deut. 18:15-19

Those who are truly converted to the life of Christ, certainly want to be like Him. Of course to achieve Christ-likeness all believers must daily commit themselves to walking in His footsteps (**1 Pet. 2:21**). This is achieved as disciples follow the teaching of Jesus described throughout the Bible. *I would suggest that the basics include daily study and reflection over the scriptures, a commitment to prayer, and a sincere desire to live a life of holiness, righteousness and truth as was demonstrated by the Lord.* When potential converts to the Kingdom of God are given an opportunity to experience authentic discipleship because we take the time to allow each person to confirm their commitment to God in Christ, then they will become life-long participants in the church’s commitment to make new disciples.

It appears to me that any sincere seeker of truth (the object of salvation) would want to understand first, who Jesus is. Essentially, this is necessary for people to place their full and total commitment with confidence in Jesus as they follow Him (**Luke 14:26, 27, 33**).

There are a host of Old and New Testament scriptures that prove that Jesus Christ is the Son of God and that the Bible is the Word of God. In this article, I will focus exclusively on Jesus Christ as the Son of God. The illumination of Jesus as the Son of God is critical for people to embrace Him as the source of all truth (**John 12:48; John 17:17**). The following passages of scripture and a brief exposition of their meaning are being offered to us for our understanding and to share with those who we are actively helping to find their way to the truth (**John 8:31, 32**).

Please consider as we progress through the disciple-making process here that we remember that relationship building must correspond with our teaching. Please prepare yourself to make sacrifices that often require us to go out of our way to confirm our sincere support of another’s journey to a life in Christ. A picture is worth a thousand words.

As a seeker comes to understand Jesus as the Son of God, they will then recognize the Bible as the word of God; thus authority for their new life in Christ. First, **Deut. 18:15**, is a prophecy (God forth telling) to believers of the eventual promise of one who will come in the likeness of Moses. Jesus is that promised Son. **Hebrews 1:5, 6** expresses that God speaks through His Son and we ought to obey Him. In **Matthew 3:16- 17**, after the Lord’s baptism, a voice from heaven declares that God is pleased with Him and we as disciples are charged to listen to what He says. Equally important, **1 John 4:10** states that God’s love for us compelled Him to allow Jesus to pay the price for our sins. And if we believe in Him and love Him (**John 3:36**) we may ask for anything that will glorify the Father and He has the power to grant it (**John 14:13,14**). Interestingly, those in darkness also know that Jesus is the Son of God and fear Him as the one who will cast them into outer darkness (**Lk. 8:28**).

In **Romans 1:1-6** we observe the assurance of Jesus to save us because of His resurrection from the dead. Ultimately we are admonished to believe in the Son of God in order to avoid eternal damnation (**1 John 5:10**).

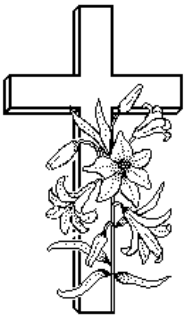
